(Bitburg, Germany) 4.8%ABV | 38 IBU  
Crisp, clear, mature and agreeable, delicately tart with a pleasant bite, and a strong yet balanced hop.

**Veltins Pilsner** 7/9

(Meschede-Grevenstein, Germany) 4.8%ABV | 24 IBU  
Founded in 1824 by Franz Kramer, crisp, clear, mature and agreeable, refreshing balanced bite

(München, Germany) 5.5%ABV | 14 IBU  
Founded in 1634 by the Minim friars, refreshing sparkling taste with notes of bananas and clove.

**Stiegl Grapefruit Radler** 7/9

(Salzburg, Austria) 2.5%ABV | 10 IBU  
Crisp & refreshingly fruity mix of natural bubbly grapefruit juice, citrus aroma, tart flavor, revitalizing sparkle.

**Paulaner Oktoberfest Marzen** 7/9

(München, Germany) 5.8%ABV | 20 IBU  
Amber beer developed over 200 years ago to celebrate Oktoberfest; full bodied with rich malt flavor, subtle hop.

**Köstritzer Schwarzbier** 7/9

(Frankfurt, Germany) 4.8%ABV | 22 IBU  
Bold and complex dark lager with subtle hints of chocolate, coffee and roasted malt sweetness balanced by a crisp finish.

## White Wines

**Schloss Johannisburg Riesling Trocken** 17/62  
(Rheingau, Germany) Distinctly complex, with herbal notes alongside citrus fruits. 1,200 years of viticultural history in the world's first Riesling wine estate. Founded as a Benedictine monastery, the Johannisberg abbey became a focal point and initiator in the Rheingau.

**Brunn, Grüner Veltliner** 11/39  
(Niederösterreich, Weinland, Austria) Notes of pear, green apple, apricot, and white peach. As 6th Generation winemakers, the Steinschadens employ a traditional basket press dating back to 1564 A.D. and practice traditional fermentation in large neutral Slavonian Oak vats held in an ancient historic subterranean cellar. Their Ried Stein vineyard is listed as one of only 52 "Erste Lage" vineyards in Austria.

**Schmitt Söhne Riesling Trocken** 11/40  
(Rheinhessen, Germany) Mouthwatering and dry with aromas of crisp green apple and zesty citrus. Bold and brilliant, its notes of bright acidity are balanced with rich flavors of white peach and honeysuckle. This medium-bodied wine is well structured, leading to a long lasting finish.

**Brigadoon Pinot Blanc** 15/54  
(Willamette Valley) Refreshing light, tart and loaded with citrus fruit flavors, this zesty wine mixes lemon, lime and pineapple highlights. With roots in Napa Valley's Rutherford vineyard, this winemaker holds to a tradition of hands-on organic farming.

**Ryan Patrick, 'Rock Island' Chardonnay** 11/39  
(Columbia Valley, WA) Clean, crisp apple and pear focused. Aspects of fresh bread, vanilla custard and stone fruit compliment these primary characters of this more traditional chardonnay.

**Alexandria Nichole a<sup>2</sup> Pinot Gris** 12/42  
(Columbia Valley, WA) The delicate aromatics give way to notes of nectarine, white peach, pear and lemon zest. There's a crispness to this refreshing summer sipper.

## Rosé Wines

**Villa Wolf Pinot Noir Rose** 10/36  
(Pfalz, Germany) Light and refreshing, with bright berry and fruit flavors. True rosé, made with a brief maceration before pressing to extract color. Pfalz is in a warm, dry, Palatinate region of the Rhine Valley, ensuring ripeness in the weathered sandstone.

## Red Wines

**Marshall Davis Pinot Noir** 16/59  
A blend of fruit from the Estate Vineyard and Hirschy Vineyard. Both vineyards are located in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA of the Willamette Valley, which is at the same latitude as the Burgundy region of France.

**La Querce Seconda** 17/62  
**2017 Chianti Classico** Sangiovese  
(Tuscany, Italy) Incredible depth of flavor, class and a remarkable structure of integrated tannins, acidity, a long, well-balanced finish and a beautifully harmonious aroma; complex with notes of red fruit, currant, plum, spice, light balsamic, and eucalyptus. The family of the La Querce II vineyard, in the northernmost corner of the Chianti Classico region, tends to their grapes surrounded by the rolling hills of their olive orchards.

**Bodegas Las Orcas, Solar de Randez** 15/56  
**2016 Rioja Finca San Angel** Tempranillo  
(Laguardia, Rioja Alavesa, Spain) This Tempranillo red wine shows gentle yet firm layers of fruit and spice, while mixing with traditional aromas and flavors of La Rioja such as game and leather. Nestled in the foothills of the Sierra Cantabrian Mountains, the underground wineries of Laguardia date back to the Middle Ages.

**Alki 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon** 13/49  
(Columbia Valley, WA) Aromas and flavors of cocoa, coconut, baking spice and black cherry, pleasantly balanced with fruit and barrel both playing their role.

**Maipe Malbec** 12/44  
(Mendoza, Argentina) Complex aromas of plum, fig, strawberry, spices and floral notes; rounded and velvety tannins. At their source in foothills of the Andes Mountains, Argentineans still invoke Maipe, Lord of the Winds, to clear the skies after heavy rain or summer heat.

## Sparkling White Wines

**Chandon Brut** (187ml split) 14  
(California) Crisp, fresh, green apple, pear and citrus notes precede a soft, dry finish. The prestigious Epernay Champagne winery Moët & Chandon layed roots in California with the Chandon vineyards in 1973.

**Dr. Loosen Riesling Sekt** 8/32  
(Mosel, Germany) Fruit and floral tones with ripe nectarine, yellow plum and lemon flavors. Ernst and Thomas Loosen work with small local growers to obtain quality and sustainable, healthy and perfectly ripe fruit.

## Sommelier Select Wines

**White Walnut Pinot Noir** 2020 Vintage 99  
(Willamette Valley) Master winemaker Chris Mazepink produced this rare gem, his own vineyard's first harvest, exclusively available to those who visit the grounds. We did. It's the very best Oregon wine we serve. Enjoy!

**Résonance Pinot Noir** 2015 Vintage 93  
(Willamette Valley) Medium ruby, hints of baked blackberries, blueberry coulis, toasted coconut, autumn leaves and dried violets with hints of earth and a classic framing of sweet spice

**Domaine Roy & Fils Pinot Noir** 2019 Vintage 97  
(Willamette Valley) Iron runs down the spine. Tart raspberry is framed with lemon and fresh herbs. Aged eleven months in neutral French Oak

**Winderlea Pinot Noir** 2017 Vintage 99  
(Willamette Valley) Ruby in color, concentrated aromas of bramble fruit, mint, cedar and graphite, silky palate with jammy notes of blackberry and cherry cobbler, accented by dried herbs and minerality

**Remi Wines Dolcetto** 2018 Vintage 65  
(Willamette Valley) Nose of...blueberries! With hints of cherries and dusty, clay earth. Palate is dark plum, black tea, bay leaf with a dusty, sage finish. Grown at Jubilee Vineyard in the Northern part of the Eola-Amity Hills. Barrel aged 14 months.

**Remi Wines Lagrein** 2018 Vintage 85  
Tastes of complex raspberry cordial, with hints of the woods, cloves, anise, fennel and violets. Barrel aged 24 months

**Domaine Roy & Fils Chardonnay** 2019 Vintage 97  
(Willamette Valley) Rich green apple, white peach and jicama with hints of mineral, fresh herbs, lemon verbena and chamomile tea trailing out the finish

**J.L. Kiff Pinot Noir** 2015 Vintage 80  
(Willamette Valley) Sourced entirely from the estate, supple, juicy jumble of raspberry, marionberry and blackberry, with a touch of toast and coffee, polished, fully ripened tannins
